

Minutes of the Town Hall Committee held at 7pm on 25th April 2019 at the Town Hall

Persons present Cllrs Byles (Chair), Evitt, Smith and Blake

1. Apologies for absence Cllr Hudson and Berry (co opted member)
2. Current Lettings of the Town Hall – Cllr Byles reported we are on target to make £12,000 this financial year.
3. The proposed Leaflet to advertise the Town Hall drafted by Cllr Byles was considered and approved. Cllr Byles will contact a local graphic designer to prepare a leaflet and also to prepare a small advert to be placed in the Eye Magazine and Village People .
4. Relations with neighbours of the Town Hall. Cllr Byles reported she continues to liaise with the neighbour who is most concerned about noise from the Town Hall and to monitor events with Cllr Ribchester. So far all is going well.
5. An Audio system for the Town Hall. It was agreed this is needed but that the Committee is not quite sure what sort of audio is needed. It was agreed Cllr Byles will discuss our needs with a local resident who works in this field.
6. New lighting in the Council Chamber – Cllr Berry to chase this up with our general electrical contractor.
7. The Clock in the Clock Tower – it was agreed a note explaining the position regarding a repair will be placed in Eye to Eye.
8. Polishing the Town Hall floor. The Contract of employment of the caretaker was considered and it was noted this was amongst his duties. Cllr Byles will contact the caretaker to see what help he requires.
9. A youth club or youth drop in centre in Eye. Cllr Byles is liaising with Johnny Abbott of the Forge Church Eye to develop the idea of a youth drop in on Friday late afternoons and evenings – not in the Town Hall but in the Community Centre because the skateboard park is nearby which is a youth attraction.
