1. Apologies for absence received from Cllr Smith none received from Cllr Hudson and Cllr Crispin.
2. Minutes of the last meeting held on the 11th July 2017 were confirmed and proposed as a true record by Cllr Cooper and seconded by Cllr Blake
3. Bus Shelter – Broad Street
The Environment Committee have been asked to consider sponsorship of £100 to the Bus Shelter Working Group to complete refurbishment of the shelter. Sponsorship from a company has already been obtained for the paint. This will allow Guy Mcgregor to raise further funding.
