

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL
(PARISHES OF EYE AND YAXLEY) (C527 CASTLETON WAY)
(30 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2023**

On 24 April 2023 Suffolk County Council made the above order for Eye and Yaxley under Section 84 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which would be:

- To extend the existing 30mph speed limit on Castleton Way (C527) for approximately 45 metres in a westerly direction; from a point 280 metres west of the centre of its junction with Millfield (measured along the new road alignment) for 24 metres westwards. The remaining part of the extended speed limit will be subject to 30 mph by virtue of new street lighting.
- Redefine the existing 50mph speed limit on Castleton Way (C527); from a point 304 metres west of the centre of its junction with Millfield, Eye (measured along the new road alignment) to, and including, the roundabout junction on the A140 Ipswich Road, Yaxley, for a distance of 1120 metres.
- To revoke the previous order bearing citation, Suffolk County Council (Parish of Yaxley) (C527 Castleton Way) (50 mph speed limit) Order 2021.

A copy of the order which comes into effect on 26 April 2023 and a map showing the length of road affected, may be seen with advance notice at the address below, 9.00 a.m. – 5.00 p.m. Monday – Friday; also at Eye Library, 6 Cross Street, Eye, IP23 7AA, on Tuesday 9am-1pm; Wednesday 9am-1pm and 2pm - 6pm; Thursday 2pm - 5pm; Friday 9am - 1pm and 2pm - 5pm; Saturday 9am - 1pm and Sunday 10am - 3pm.

If anyone wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any of the requirements of the Act or any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for this purpose.
